Excerpt from A Study of Sand-Lime Brick The possible use of the silica in the manufacture of sand-lime brick suggested the advisability of a study of the sand-lime brick process from both a theoretical and a practical standpoint, in order to determine the effect of substituting the silica for some of the sand commonly used in the process. It seemed desirable to investigate very closely the chemical and physical properties oi compounds formed from finely divided silica and lime, inasmuch as these are evidently very closely related to the bonding material in sand-lime brick, if, indeed, they are not identical with it. It had been determined by the earlier experiments that when mixed with lime, this silica enters into a reaction which results in the production of a homogeneous compound. This new substance, it was assumed, must resemble the film of hydrated calcium silicate surround ing the sand grains in sand - lime bricks.
